WALK 1 THE BONNE NUIT BLISTER Trail rating 2+

PT No 160 22Km



This is a demanding walk from Bouley Bay to Bonne Nuit and further on to Valley along the cliff paths with magnificent views. The return journey is easier through the quiet lanes of St John's and Trinity.

Mourier

Climb the path and after 350m take right hand sign "cliffpath". Beautiful views of the French coast and Les Dirouelles and Les Echreous reefs in between. After 1300m you come to a crosspath in the middle of a small wood, turn right and follow cliff path sign to Bonne Nuit. 400m further on you will arrive at a little cottage called Wolf's Lair.

Question: What is on the ground by the gate of the cottage?

Answer.....

After 950m there is a footpath sign, take steps on right and soon you will see Bonne Nuit Bay. After 200m you will see a sign for the upper and lower paths, take lower path and continue with the sea on your right. Soon you will reach La Crete Fort(which is the private residence of the Lieutenant Governor of the Island), continue up the small road past some houses, and after 550m you join the main road, turn right down the hill. Keep left, you can drop down to the bay where there are refreshments and toilets. The hill rises steeply and after 500m you will reach the sign"footpath". There is a steep climb to a great viewing point, it is very stony so be careful! After 750m you reach Wolves Caves, and after another 700m you reach the coast road again, turn right onto a gravel pavement, keep sea on your right, magnificent views.

After 1100m you will reach Les Fontaines Tavern and toilets. At this point you can make a small detour on right to the coastal viewing point, well worth a visit for an extra 500m. On past Ronez Quarry (which is the islands main quarry). After 550m turn right to Sorel point. After 150m turn left onto the cliffpath and follow the footpath sign, with views of the Paternoster Reef and Sark behind. Keep sea on your right and after 700m you will reach Mourier Valley.

Question. Are there any windows in the front of the pump house building?

Answer.....

At the base of Mourier Valley start to climb the rough road, after 550m you will reach he road, turn left and the road starts to rise. After 400m turn left into Le Mont de la Barcelone, this rises steeply into La Rue de Sorel. Straight on into Le Canibut, follow the lane past a large clump of trees in front of Century House. After 1000m there is a yellow line(If you wish to make a small detour turn left. There is a very nice house called Le Mottais Farm.) Turn right at the yellow line, the road bears left past a house called Kungsater.

After 800m, you will arrive at a crossroad, go straight across into La Rue de l'Eglise, after 100m you should see lots of chickens on your left. After 700m you will reach a small crossroad, turn right and after 150m there is a T junction, turn left into Route de Mont Mado. After 900m take left turn into La Rue des Chataigniers, lane wind right and left.

After 400m there is a T junction with a granite house in front called Hautmont . Turn right onto the small main road and after 500m you will reach a viewing point. After 950m the road bears right then left, after a further 500m turn into La Vielle Charriere. After 150m road bears right, continue down the hill for 1100m back to Bouley Bay.
