The Heritage Trail. PT 187 10km Walk 7 Trail rating 1

With Hampton behind you turn left down the road to the T junction with Les Charriere Nicolle, turn right. After 300m you come to Dannemarche reservoir. (There is a very nice footpath that runs alongside the righthand side of the road). After 650m there is a cross roads.

Question. At this junction with Le Mont. du Bu de la Rue, what is written on the large Grey granite stone?

Answer.

Bear right at this junction and after 950m you reach Millbrook reservoir. Continue and after 1100m you reach a T junction with the main road, turn right and continue past the Mont Felard Hotel and turn right by Richmond Court into Rue du Haut.

Question: On your left you will pass Millbrook House, what is the inscription on the pillars?

Answer.

After 450m turn right into Le Mont Cambrai, continue up the hill passing The Grove on your left. After 850m you come to a junction with the main road, continue straight up La Grande Route de St Laurent and after just 50m you will see a sign for The Underground Hospital, turn left here into La rue de la Ville Emphrie.

After 800m you will reach The Underground Hospital. Well worth a visit.

Turn right into a green lane called Les Charrieres de Malory, the hill climbs, past the sign that says "Caution Squirrels". After 1000m you come to a T junction, turn left and after 150m you come to another junction, turn right into Rue de la Fontaine St Martin with Morel Farm on your left. Go down the hill and after 450m turn left by Le Rat Cottage, these two properties are fine examples of typical old Jersey houses. 150m further on there is a T junction, turn left. After 150m turn right and after another 150m you are at the main road. Turn right for 50m then immediately left along the lane with a paddock on the left, 150m down this road you come to a T junction, turn left and follow the signs back down to Hamptonne Country Life Museum. From here you can start the return journey on the Hamptonne Hack.
