JAMBO'S JAUNT PT162 15km Walk 3 Trail rating 2



This walk takes you along the coastal path down to Rozel Bay , on through the woods, past the pretty little bays of La Coupe, Fliquet and St Catherines. The return is through St Catherine's Woods and back through the lanes.

The cliff path starts by the Black Dog pub. Climb the steps until the path levels off. You cross over a small wooden bridge and then the path climbs through the woods, keep the sea on your left all the time. You will pass a house called Son de la Mer, and on the left after 300m there is another little path. DO NOT TAKE this one, but continue on the main path. 70m further on take a left hand fork in path, the path will go inland, past some wooden railings. After 1100m you will reach a car park. Here there are great views of France and the outlying Les Ecrehrous reef.

To continue take the tarmac road out of the car park, and after 350m you come to a small road, turn left at a house called Le Catel. The hill descends towards Rozel Bay.

Question: What is the name of the house opposite a large TV aerial on right?

Answer.

After 600m you will reach the Mimosa Café on your left. Immediately left takes you into Rozel bay, where there are toilets and refreshments, Continuing , bear left by Apple Cottage and head up NLe Mont du Rozel(no sign), 800m to top of hill with Frere de Mer Restaurant on left. 100m further on is a sign for Rue des Fontennes. Turn sharp left onto the public footpath. This is a rough track, keep to main track and after 250m you pass a small reservoir on your right. Another 200m you reach a small road, turn right up the tarmac road which goes inland, soon you reach a sign Rue de la Coupe on left, and after another 150m you reach a crossroads. Turn left into Rue de la Perruque passing a beautiful house on your right called La Perruque. As you descend the hill there are lovely views of the French coast and Les Ecrehrous reef. After 600m you reach Fliquet Bay and the Martello Tower.

Question . What is the name of the house directly opposite the Martello Tower?

Answer.

The road climbs, and after 200

.m you will see wooden style on the left with a footpath sign, follow this. Keep left and after 250m you will reach St Catherines Beakwater. Here there are toilets and a café. Continue along road past café and Canoe Club, and get onto the footpath which runs parallel with the road. After 800m you will arrive at a slipway and a Martello Tower.

Go back onto the road and continue past a small reservoir on the right, 130m further on you arrive at a small crossroads, turn right by the postbox, then left at the fork.

After 230m you come to a reservoir on the right, keep to the path, over the stepping stones keeping to the main path, after 100m go left over 4 stepping stones. Follow path with the stream on your right, past a sign entitled "St Catherines Woodland" with a fork in the path. Take left hand path, keep left as the path starts to climb. After 300m, you come to a granite farm called Milton Farm.

Question. What is the date on top of the granite archway?

Answer.

Continue on road past a house on right called Bel Air and a chapel. After 400m you come to a main road, turn left and you are soon at the Royal Pub and restaurant. Refreshment time. Turn right out of out of the pub and after 150m turn right into Rue des Raïses (Green lane), past Les Raïses Cottage. Follow the lane and after 1100m you come to a T junction with a sign Rue du Puchot on right, turn right here down to the next T Junction. Turn left into Rue du Clos Fallu(no sign) past a smelly cow farm on left.

800m down to the next junction, bear right into La Profonde Rue and after just 150m turn right into Rue du Pot du Rocher which is just before the zoo. After 300m turn left into Rue du Becquet taking the right hand fork in the road. After 650m turn right into Rue de la Falaise.

Question. After 150m what is the name of the house on the right just before the common?

Answer.

From here you can get onto the cliffpath or follow the road back down the hill to Undercliff.
