ROZEL RAMBLE PT No 161 Walk 2 13Km Trail rating 2



This path actually starts towards Bonne Nuit, giving you some stunning views before turning inland through the lanes towards the east coast. A stop at Rozel Bay is a must before heading back along the cliff path to Bouley Bay.

Climb the footpath to Bonne Nuit up the steps and along the track until you reach the granite sign "Cliffpath >>". From the top of the steps follow the track, past the sign " No horses or motorcycles" Turn left just before the next footpath sign, (a concrete platform and viewing point here). Turn left up the track by the National Trust sign "Le Don Anderton", and after 600m you come to a house on the right called "Heather Brae".

Question: What is the date on the granite stone above the highest window ?

Follow the road up past the sign for Kingswood, up to the main road and turn left into La rue du Tas de Geon. 800m down to the junction of 5 roads, take the second left walking along the pavement (keep the post box on your left), after 100m turn right into La rue au Sellier. 100m down to the T junction, turn left towards Trinity Church and after 500m turn right just before the shop (No entry road). After 100m bear left into Rue du Catel, and after 500m turn right at the T junction, after 150m there is another T junction, turn right then immediately left down into a valley. This is a very quiet lane and after 800m you come to a large granite house on your left.

Question: What is the name of this house?

After 150m turn left by the sign > 6' 6" <, this is a really narrow and steep lane. At the T junction turn left passing Glenwood Farm, and after 200m turn left again passing beautiful Longfield House on your right. Follow the lane around passing Maison du Buisson on your right, past Le Maistre Bros Garden and Equestrian Store and some sheep, following the road around the back of the zoo. You will arrive a cross roads with a main road, turn right here, (be careful as this is a busy road). After 100m turn left off the main road into La rue du Clos Fallu, (no sign). You will pass North Lynn cow farm on your right. Keep left following the signs for Rozel, past a red post box on left. Keep following signs for Rozel passing Rozel Manor on your right, then turn right following the road for Fliquet and St Catherines. (Rozel Hamlet on left). Turn left into Rue du Siez and go straight on following the sign for Saie Harbour, and after 800m you will reach this pretty little bay. Turn left following the sign, " La rue des Fontenelles, Footpath to Rozel Hill"

Question: What is the collection of large stones on your right called ?

There is a terrific view point just behind these stones.

Follow the track passing the little dam and then up the track to Rozel hill, turn right her to go down to Rozel Bay. Refreshments and toilets in the bay. To continue climb the hill immediately behind the Mimosa Restaurant, you will pass a large TV aerial on your left.

Question: What is the name of the house opposite this aerial ?

Continue up the hill past Cliffside House and when you reach a house called Le Catel Vautier turn right up the track towards the car park. From here there are beautiful views of the other islands, the coast of France and the Ecrehous Reef.

From the car park follow the footpath signs all the way keeping the sea on your right and after approx one hour you will reach Bouley Bay with beautiful views all the way along.
